# Silver Lake Sportsmen's Trap League

### **General Rules**

- 1. 9 nights to shoot 8 rounds.
- 2. First night scores are used for a future make-up or missed shoot.
- 3. All scores including make-ups are scrubbed for weather cancellation.
- 4. Handicap League based on team average.
- 5. Shooting Order: First come First served.

## Safety

- 1. RULE #1 Treat a Gun as if it is always loaded
- 2. RULE #2 Never point the gun at anything you are not willing to destroy.
- 3. RULE #3 Be sure of your target and beyond.
- 4. RULE #4 Keep your finger off the trigger until you are ready to fire.
- 5. Lightning during a shoot is an immediate cancellation.
- 6. Staggered shooting is not allowed beyond 1 yard.
- 7. Never load your gun before changing positions.
- 8. Load one shell at a time unless shooting doubles.
- 9. Keep chamber open until it is your turn to shoot.
- 10. Obvious intoxication while shooting will result in an immediate removal from the trap league.

# **Spring Trap League Cost**

- 1. Fee is \$45 paid by second week.
- 2. Non-Members sell \$50 in raffle tickets.

# **Establishing Handicap**

- 1. First two nights teams shoot at the 19-yard line to establish team handicap.
- 2. High Team shoots at the 25 yard line.
- 3. Team Handicap is calculated by the average of 10 scores plus highest scoring teams offset. (Offset = 25 High Team average)
- 4. Missing scores for the first two weeks are set to 25 to calculate team handicap.
- 5. Teams shoot handicap the remainder of the league.

# **Banked Scores & Make-ups**

- 1. Make-up scores are shot in advance (except the first two weeks).
- 2. First night is used as everyone's make-up or bank score and used for the last night if no make-ups are needed.
- 3. Shooters average minus 2 is recorded for a missed round without a make-up score banked.
- 4. Dedicated make-up rounds are shot at the 19-yard line +/- 1 yard.
- 5. Individual make-up with another team shoots that team's handicap +/- 1 yard.

#### Shoot Offs

- 1. Shoot offs of like scores based on the following:
  - High Gun Shooters with the highest score
  - Random High Random number is picked of scores from 20-24 not to include High Gun.
  - Random Low Random number is picked of scores 19 or less.
- 2. Shoot offs are held midway through the shoot around 7:00 PM to allow all shooters to participate.
- 3. Make-Up/Banked scores are not eligible for shoot offs.
- 4. First shooter establishes shooting position.
- 5. Shooting position may be selected by puller at pullers discretion.
- 6. Winners of a shoot off will receive either a meat or monetary prize.
